- Course is taught by Emergency Vehicle Operations Course (EVOC) Instructors from the Suffolk County Police Academy and will consist of a short class room lecture followed by a live demonstration on the EVOC track.
- Topics to be covered include vehicle dynamics, braking, cornering, acceleration and crash avoidance.
- The goal of this course is to educate teenagers to avoid dangerous driving conditions and to supplement training already learned from D.M.V. and Defensive Driving courses.
 - Teens ages 16 to 18 are eligible to participate in the course.
