ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

A. Transfers of Firearms: I acknowledge that transferring a weapon to a person other than an immediate family member (spouse, domestic partner, child, step child) is a Crime under NYS General Business Law §898 (6), unless conducted through a duly licensed gun dealer who conducts a NICS check on the purchaser/transferee.

B. Straw Purchases: I acknowledge that §265.17 of the NYS Penal Law makes it a crime, punishable as a Class D Felony, to purchase or dispose of a firearm, rifle or shotgun to another knowing that he/she is disqualified from possessing said firearm.

C. Storage of Firearms: I acknowledge that §265.45 of the NYS Penal Law prohibits, under designated circumstances, a person from storing or leaving a rifle, shotgun or firearm out of his or her immediate possession or control without having first securely locked such rifle, shotgun or firearm in an appropriate safe storage depository, or without having rendered it incapable of being fired by use of a gun locking device appropriate for said weapon. Violation of this law is a Crime. *Note: Nothing in this section shall be deemed to affect, impair or supersede any special or local law, regulation, ordinance or act relating to the safe storage of rifles, shotguns or firearms which may impose additional requirements on the owner or custodian of such weapons.*

You are advised to obtain professional legal advice and to consult the full text of laws cited, in addition to all other applicable laws, for additional guidance on matters pertaining to firearms.
