PUBLIC NOTICE OF TITLE VI PROGRAM RIGHTS and COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT



The Suffolk County Police Department gives public notice of its policy to uphold and assure full compliance with the non-discrimination requirements of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related Nondiscrimination authorities. Title VI and related Nondiscrimination authorities stipulate that no person in the United States of America shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, income level or Limited English Proficiency be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.

The Suffolk County Police Department is committed to compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA") and shall make reasonable accommodations to provide equal and meaningful opportunity to qualified individuals with disabilities.

Any person who desires more information regarding the Suffolk County Police Department's Title VI Program or ADA Program can contact its Title VI Designee/ADA Compliance Officer - Deputy Inspector John Hanley - at the address noted below.

Any person who believes they have, individually or as a member of any specific class of persons, been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, income level or Limited English Proficiency has the right to file a formal complaint.
